

COLORS: dark/navy blue for the dark and tan for the light.

CUT: From the light - 2 3 7/8 inch squares, cut in half diagonally

4 3 1/2 squares

From the dark - 2 3 7/8 inch squares cut in half

diagonally

1 3 1/2 inch square

SEW: Sew one light and one dark triangle together four times. Press to the dark or open, as you prefer. Square to 3 1/2 inches if needed.

Sew one half-square triangle toopposite sides of a light 3 1/2 square twice.

Sew one light square to opposite sides of the 3 1/2 inch square.

Sew the three rows together with the three square row in the middle.

For EACH blue/tan patch that you make you will have one chance to win all of them, so sew lots of them! They barely take any time. Also, make an extra block each month in colors of your choice and at the end of the year, you will have enough for a lap size sampler quilt of your own.
