

COLORS: Background fabric: off white/muslin colored print (or muslin) Leaf and Stem fabric: Any color that you might see on maple trees in the fall

CUT: Background: 2 3 7/8 inch squares cut in half diagonally 2 3 1/2 inch squares

Leaf and Stem: 2 3 7/8 inch squares cut in alf diagonally 3 3 1/2 inch squares

1 6inch by 1 inch piece to be folded and ironed in thirds for the stem

Sew one background and one colored leaf fabric triangle SEW: together 4 times. Press.

Sew the stem to one background square diagonally with matching thread.

Sew 3 three squares together in 3 rows as shown.

VOILA! One maple leaf block!
