5 5 5 5 5	Cut 5 squares 2 1/8" and bisect on one diagonal Cut 1 square 5 1/4" and bisect on both diagonals
	Cut 1 square 9 ¼" and bisect on both diagonals
2	Fabric 2 Cut 4 squares 4 %" and bisect on one diagonal
3	Fabric 3 Cut 5 squares 2 %" and bisect on one diagonal
4	Fabric 4 Cut 4 squares 2 %" and bisect on one diagonal
